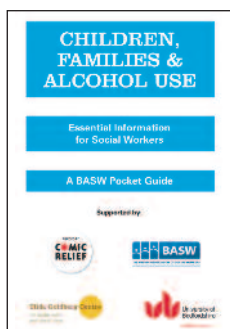


Alcohol & Other Drugs

This pocket guide seeks to support Social Workers to take professional responsibility for ensuring their knowledge and skills meet the needs of service users with alcohol and drug problems.

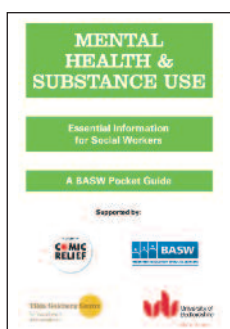

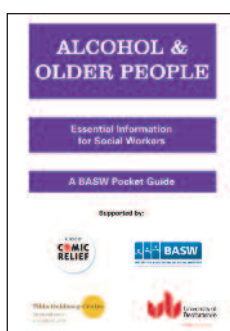

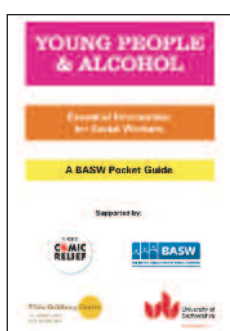
